

Directions to McCray Field from the Interstate

Get off of I40/I85 at exit 140, University Drive, and travel toward Elon (follow the signs).

You will stay on University Drive for a little over 2.5 miles until just after you cross the train tracks (through several stoplights; travel in the left lane so that you are not forced into a right-turn-only lane; the name of the road will change to Cook Road at the intersection with Westbrook Road and becomes a 2-lane road there).

Immediately after crossing the train tracks, turn right onto Burlington Road (also called Haggard Avenue).

Turn left almost immediately at the next stoplight onto Route 100 East (University Drive again). Follow Route 100 East until the next stoplight.

Turn left onto Shallowford Church Road at that light.

Then turn left at the next stoplight onto Route 87 North.

Travel on Route 87 until the stoplight at Western High School (on the right). Turn right onto Gerringer Mill Rd and follow it until it ends at Burch Bridge Rd.

Turn right onto Burch Bridge Rd. Go about ½ mile to the first road on your left (at a little shopping center).

Turn left onto Greenwood Dr and follow it until it ends at Union Ridge Rd.

Turn right and immediately you will be at Hwy. 62.

Turn left onto Hwy 62 and go about 5 miles or so and you will see a big parking lot and the ballfield on the right. The sign out front says McCray Recreational Ballfield.
