

Parental Involvement:

- a. The school will seek to involve at least one parent of all students in school-related activities.
- b. Parent Contract: The school will develop and encourage all parents to sign a Parent-School contract, which defines the obligations of both the parents and the school as partners in the education of each child. The contract will include the School obligations to teach and to document the success of each child. It will include the discipline code and a commitment of hours by each parent to contribute to the School for each child.
- c. Clover Garden School will conduct an annual meeting to inform parents of their rights and to have input in the yearly plan. In addition, the school will:
 - Involve parents in the process of annual school review and improvement planning
 - Offer parent meetings throughout the year
 - Conduct parent surveys throughout the year to assess content and effectiveness of various programs
 - Provide opportunities for parental participation by assisting parents who are disabled, economically disadvantaged, have limited English proficiency, and are of all racial and ethnic backgrounds
 - Share School-Parent Compact which outlines how the school, parents, and students will share the responsibility for ensuring student achievement

Clover Garden School will promote opportunities for parents to conference with teachers about their child's progress. Parents will be invited to visit classrooms, eat lunch with their children, and volunteer their services in school activities.
